Gypsy site by Jen's Café – An extra static caravan/prefabricated unit has turned up on the site. Cllr Cawood has asked Cllr Skidmore to provide an update. Mr Lewis to write to the Inspectorate on behalf of TPC.

Lighting at junction of A361. Cllr Cawood has not come back yet but is looking into providing funding.

Manual street sweep. Automated sweep now done once every two months. Does not clean properly down Foghamshire Lane. Needs manual sweep to remove weeds and horse manure. RL to write to Council again requesting hand sweep, SD to take photographs of affected areas after road resurfacing has taken place.

Verge grass at junction with A361. SCC will not cut the brambles back. RL to write to the council again querying where the verge boundary is, who owns the land, and as it was cut back last year, why can it not be done again this year.
